School Reminders

As we are at the start of new term please read through the following changes and important information.

School meals are £2.40per day and we ask payments to be made in advance payable via Parent Pay.

When collecting your children at the end of each day, please can we ask you to stand behind the yellow line, this allows the teacher to have sight of the parents before discharging the children safely.

Breakfast Club

If you require your child to attend breakfast club, it must be booked on the Friday before the week commencing and paid for in full on Parent Pay. At the time of booking, please send an email to tickle.v@crosslee.manchester.sch.uk confirming the days/weeks your child is attending. The club will be available on a first come, first served basis and will be available every Friday to book for the week ahead. Cereal, bagels, toast and juice will be served alongside a variety of games and activities for the children to play.

Please note, children can only attend who have booked and paid via ParentPay.
